## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Increasing Salary of the Adjutant General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 14, § 11, amended. The 9th paragraph of section 11 of chapter 14 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 2 of chapter 361 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'The Adjutant General shall receive an annual salary of \$10,000 \$11,500. He shall receive no other fee, emolument or perquisite.'

(There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$1,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and \$1,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 to carry out the purposes of this section.)

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall be retroactive to July 1, 1961.
