SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 729, L. D. 1017, Bill, "An Act to Incorporate the Domestic Finance Corporation of Kennebunk."

Amend said Bill in the title by striking out the word "Kennebunk" and inserting in place thereof the word 'Waterville'. Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 7th line the word "Kennebunk" and inserting in place thereof the word 'Waterville'.

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 2. Principal office. The principal office and place of business in Maine is to be located in the City of Waterville, County of Kennebec, or as fixed by the directors.'
