**AN ACT Authorizing School Administrative Units to Contract for Driver
Education Courses.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 218-B, amended. Section 218-B of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Whenever an administrative unit offers an approved driver education course and is unable to make the course available to any pupil within the unit desiring it, the superintending school committee may contract for instruction of the pupil with any person licensed under chapter 22, section 60 A, to give driver education courses. The superintending school committee shall pay to such person, upon receipt from the State, that part of the special subsidy allocated for such pupil, together with that pupil's share of the appropriation made by the administrative unit for driver education.
