STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Establishing Minimum Pay for Persons Hauling Gravel on State and Municipal Contracts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 15-A, § 26-A, additional. Chapter 15-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 340 of the public laws of 1957, is amended by adding a new section 26-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 26-A. Minimum pay rate for hauling gravel on state contracts. Any person who contracts or enters into an agreement with the State to haul dirt or gravel for the State, using his own or another's vehicle, shall be paid at least \$1 per hour for each cubic yard capacity of the hauling vehicle.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 90-A, § sub-§ II, ¶ A, amended. Paragraph A of subsection II of section 12 of chapter 90-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'A. Providing for public buildings, ways, bridges, parks, parking places, sewers and drains. Any person who contracts or enters into an agreement with a municipality to haul dirt or gravel for the municipality, using his own or another's vehicle, shall be paid at least \$1 per hour for each cubic yard capacity of the hauling vehicle.'
