**Resolve, Authorizing Study of Road from Allagash Plantation to the  
Canadian Border.**

---

**Road from Allagash Plantation to Canadian Border; study authorized. Resolved:** That the State Highway Commission is authorized and directed to make a study of the need and cost of a highway extending about 40 miles from Allagash Plantation (Little Black Brook) Aroostook County to the Canadian border along the St. John River; and be it further

**Resolved:** That the commission shall report the results of their study at the next regular session of the Legislature.
