STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Bounty on Bobcat.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 121, amended. The first sentence of section 121 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'There shall be a bounty of \$15 \$25 for every bobcat, loupcervier and Canada lynx which is killed within the State, to be paid by the Treasurer of State to the person killing the same upon compliance with the following conditions.'
