STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Shortening Waiting Period Under Workmen's Compensation Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 31, § 10. Section 10 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 10. Waiting period; when compensation payable. No compensation for incapacity to work shall be payable for the first 7 days of incapacity; provided, however, that. In case incapacity continues for more than 28 14 days, compensation shall be allowed from the date of incapacity.'
