# STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Relating to Power of Universalist Church of Maine to Hold Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Power to hold property.** The Universalist Church of Maine is authorized and empowered to receive, hold and convey real property, personal property and property of every description, or any interest therein, without limit as to value, in trust of any type and description, or in complete ownership, in furtherance of any of the powers and purposes of the corporation, or, if in trust, for any otherwise lawful purpose set forth in the trust instrument and not inconsistent with the purposes of this corporation.
