STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Fish and Game Warden Benefits Under Maine State Retirement System.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 63-A, § 6, sub-§ VIII, additional. Section 6 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955 and as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection VIII to read as follows:

'VIII. Fish and game wardens. Notwithstanding any provisions in this chapter to the contrary, any warden of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game, upon retirement under the ordinary disability retirement allowance provision or under subsection IV, paragraphs A to C, shall be entitled to have his benefits figured on the basis of 1/50 for each year of service as applied to his average highest compensation, and if said computation results in more than $\frac{1}{2}$ pay, he shall become entitled to the greater amount.'
