## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Exempting Estates of Blind Persons from Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 91-A, § 10, sub-§ IV, ¶ B, amended. Paragraph B of subsection IV of section 10 of chapter 91-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 399 of the public laws of 1955, is amended to read as follows:
  - 'B. The polls and estates up to the value of \$3,000 of persons who are blind.'
