STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Attorney and Assistant County Attorneys of Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. That part of the 4th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959, which relates to the salaries of the county attorney and assistant county attorneys of Cumberland County, is amended to read as follows:

'county attorney, $\$_{3,000}$ \$6,000; first assistant county attorney, $\$_{3,750}$ \$4,500; second assistant county attorney, $\$_{3,300}$ \$4,000;'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General to carry out the purpose of section 1 the sum of \$1,835 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and the sum of \$2,450 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963; the breakdown of which shall be as follows:
