STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Establishment of a School of Practical Nursing in Portland or Vicinity.

Establishment of a School of Practical Nursing; appropriation for. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Education the sum of \$109,292 for the purpose of establishing and operating a State School of Practical Nursing in Portland or the vicinity.

This appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a carrying account until the purpose of this resolve has been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

There is a continuing demand for practical nurses. A school in the Portland area would help to meet this demand and would offer an opportunity to young women in the area to receive the benefits of practical nurse training.
