STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Weekly Benefits for Total Unemployment Under Employment Security Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 13, sub-§ II, repealed and replaced. Subsection II of section 13 of chapter 29 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by chapter 341 of the public laws of 1957, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'II. Weekly benefit amount for total unemployment. On and after April 1, 1961, each eligible individual who is totally unemployed in any week shall be paid with respect to such week, benefits at the rate of 1.1% of his annual wage but no greater than 50% of the average weekly wage paid by employers subject to the Maine Employment Security Law. Such benefits shall be paid for a period of 26 weeks during any one benefit year.'
