AN ACT Defining Public Place Under Law Regulating Drinking in Public Places.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 96, sub-§ II, amended. Subsection II of section 96 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'II. Public place defined. "Public place" as used in this section shall mean any common carrier, dance, entertainment, amusement or sport or grounds adjacent thereto and used in conjunction therewith, **municipally owned or leased buildings or parking lots**, or any highway, street or lane, to which the public is invited or has access.'
