COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 353, L. D. 1086, Bill, "An Act
to Clarify the Liquor Laws."

Amend said Bill by adding after section 4, 2 new sections
as follows:

"Sec. 4-A. R. S., c. 61, §31, amended. The 2nd sentence
of the 3rd paragraph of section 31 of chapter 61 of the Revised
Statutes, as enacted by chapter 144 of the public laws of 1957,
is repealed as follows:

'A-part-time-hotel-licensee-shall-conduct-his-hotel-business-on
the-premises-only-during-the-time-when-such-part-time-license-is
in-effect.'

Sec. 4-B. R. S., c. 61, §51, amended. The 2nd paragraph
of section 51 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is amended by
adding at the end a new sentence, as follows:

'Any licensee who accepts an order or receives payment for liquor
from a minor shall be considered as in violation of this paragraph.' "
