SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 353, L. D. 1086, Bill, "An Act to Clarify the Liquor Laws."

Amend said Bill by adding at the end a new section 8 to read as follows:

'Sec. 8. P.L., 1961, c. 151, repealed; limitation. Chapter 151 of the public laws of 1961, heretofore passed by this Legislature, amending section 48 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, permitting the sale of liquor in clubs to members of veterans' organizations and auxiliaries, is repealed and shall not be printed as part of the Session Laws of 1961.'
