SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 353, L. D. 1086, Bill, "An Act  
to Clarify the Liquor Laws."

Amend said Bill by adding after the enacting clause, the  
following:

"Sec. 1. R. S., c. 61, §1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 61  
of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding  
at the end a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'Places located on fairgrounds operated by agricultural  
societies or where pari mutuel racing is conducted, which  
otherwise meet the definition of a hotel or a restaurant, shall  
be deemed to be a hotel or restaurant for purposes of this  
chapter notwithstanding the fact an admission charge must be  
paid to gain entrance to such place.'"

Further amend said Bill by renumbering sections 1 to 7 to  
be sections 2 to 8.
