STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Forest Commissioner.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 36, § 1, amended. The last sentence of section 1 of chapter 36 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 12 of chapter 418 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'The commissioner (Forest) shall receive an annual salary of \$12,750, of which amount \$7,500 \$8,500 shall be paid from funds raised and created by the tax assessed under the provisions of section 96.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Forestry the sum of \$500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and the sum of \$500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 to provide for the increase in salary of the Forest Commissioner. The breakdown shall be as follows:

Sec. 3. Effective date. The provisions of this act shall be retroactive to July 1, 1961.
