RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Military Defense Commission to Convey Certain Land in Hancock County.

State Military Defense Commission authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the State Military Defense Commission is authorized and directed to sell and convey the interest of the State in and to the several lots or parcels of land comprising Township No. 4, Northern Division, Hancock County, excluding the public lots in said township, for such amounts as it shall deem fair and just, the proceeds of sale to be credited to the Military Defense Bond Fund.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Military Defense Commission acquired certain rights in T. 4, N. D., Hancock County, in 1944-45 for the establishment of an artillery range and military area. The Commission has never put the land to use and it is no longer deemed suitable for the purpose for which it was acquired.
