SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 362, L. D. 1095, Resolve,
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Authorizing
the Construction of Industrial Buildings.

"Shall the Constitution be amended as proposed by a
resolution of the Legislature permitting the registered voters
of a municipality to authorize the issuance of notes or bonds

buildings for industrial use?"'
