STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Requiring Examination for Motor Vehicle Operator's License for Persons Sixty-five Years of Age and Older.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 60, amended. Section 60 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding after the 6th sentence, the following sentences:

'Any person reaching his 65th birthday shall be required to take an examination to qualify him to operate a motor vehicle. He shall be required to take such examination every 5 years until he reaches the age of 80, after which time he shall be required to take such examination annually.'
