STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Prices of Milk Sold by Producers to Dealers by Bulk Tank.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 4, amended. The last paragraph of section 4 of chapter 33 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 341 of the public laws of 1955, is amended to read as follows:

'The minimum prices established for sales of milk by producers to dealers shall, if such sales are made by bulk tank, be increased by such amounts roc per hundredweight as may be determined by the Maine Milk Commission. Violation of this paragraph shall be sufficient cause for the Maine Milk Commission to revoke or withhold a dealer's license.'
