## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Relating to Rehabilitation of Aid to Dependent Children Families.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 25, § 246-A, additional. Chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 246-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 246-A. Rehabilitation. The Department of Health and Welfare is authorized to provide special rehabilitation and case work services to applicants and recipients of aid to dependent children to provide for the strengthening or rehabilitation of the family group.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$75,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and \$75,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 to carry out the purposes of this act.
