STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Tuition for Summer School Attendance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 44, amended. The first sentence of the 4th paragraph of section 44 of chapter 41 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 22 of chapter 364 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

'Subject to the provisions of this section and subject to such reasonable regulations as the superintending school committee or school directors shall from time to time prescribe, every person between the ages of 5 and 21 shall have the right to attend the public schools in the administrative unit in which his parent or guardian has residence, except that tuition, not exceeding the per capita cost may be charged for summer school attendance.'
