HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to Committee Amendment "A" to H. P. 800,
L. D. 1114, Bill, "An Act Relating to Tuition for Pupils
Attending Secondary School **Outside** of Residence."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the last 5 lines
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'insurance and ~~6%~~ 8% of the insured value of the school buildings
and equipment, said sums to be taken from reports filed with the
commissioner in the year for which tuition is being computed, (2)
divide the total by the average daily membership of all regularly
enrolled students of the preceding school year.' "
