SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 809, L. D. 1123, Bill, "An Act to
Field Trials for Beagle Hounds."

Amend said Bill in the title by adding after the word
"ACT" the word 'Relating'.

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

"R. S., c. 37, §117-B, additional. Chapter 37 of the
Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new section
117-B, to read as follows:

'Sec. 117-B. Field trials for beagle hounds. It shall be
lawful to hold beagle hound field trials at any time provided such
trials are A.K.C. licensed and conducted by duly organized and
recognized clubs. During the field trials permitted in this section,
no person shall use any firearm other than a pistol loaded with
blank ammunition.'"
