STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT to Field Trials for Beagle Hounds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 117, amended. Section 117 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 117. Field trials for bird dogs, coon dogs or beagle hounds. It shall be lawful to hold bird dog or coon dog field trials at any time. It shall be lawful to hold beagle hound field trials at any time provided such trials are licensed and conducted by duly organized and recognized clubs. During the field trials permitted in this section, no person shall use any firearm other than a pistol loaded with blank ammunition.'
