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AN ACT Relating to Search and Seizure of Vehicles Containing Liquor.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 61, § 82, amended.** Section 82 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 82. Seizure and forfeiture of vehicles containing liquor.** All automobiles, trucks, wagons, boats or vessels, and vehicles of every kind, not common carriers, containing liquors intended for illegal sale **or which have been so used** shall be seized by any officers seizing the liquors transported therein, and shall be libeled as is provided for the libeling of liquors and the vessels in which they are contained, and shall be declared forfeited by the court and sold in the same manner as is provided for the sale of vessels containing liquors.'
