IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Repealing the Laws Prohibiting and Regulating Work and Business on Sunday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 134, §§ 35, 38, 38-A, 39-41, 43, 44, repealed. Sections 35 and 38, section 38-A, as enacted by section 2 of chapter 302 of the public laws of 1959, sections 39 to 41 and sections 43 and 44, all of chapter 134 of the Revised Statutes, are repealed.
