# STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

### AN ACT Permitting Sale of Liquor for One Hour After Midnight.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 27, amended. The first sentence of section 27 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 311 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'No liquor shall be sold in this State on Sundays and no licensee by himself, clerk, servant or agent shall between the hours of midnight I A. M. and 6 A. M. sell or deliver any liquors, except no liquors shall be sold or delivered on Saturdays after 11:45 P. M.'
