STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Motor Carriers Operating as School Buses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 48, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 48 of chapter 22 is amended to read as follows:

Buses operated by a motor carrier having a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by the Public Utilities Commission under the provisions of sections + to +8, inclusive of chapter 48, sections r to 18, which comply with the requirements of the commission, within a city in which such carrier is so authorized to operate, shall not be regarded as "school buses"; except that such buses when operating as school buses outside the compact or built-up portions of a municipality shall conform to the lighting and sign requirements of school buses."
