STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Permitting Municipalities to Contract for Public Telephones Along Public Ways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 90-A, § 3, sub-§ II, ¶ F, additional. Subsection II of section 3 of chapter 90-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1957, and as amended, is further amended by adding a new paragraph F, to read as follows:
 - 'F. To authorize its municipal officers to contract on such terms and conditions as are in the best interests of its inhabitants for the placing and maintenance of public telephones, telephone booths and other appurtenances thereto along the public ways of the municipality. All such telephones, telephone booths and appurtenances thereto shall be located in accordance with applicable municipal ordinances or contracts relating to public ways and when said telephones, telephone booths and appurtenances exist in accordance with such ordinances or contracts, they are not defects in public ways.

The revenue received by the municipality from such contract shall be credited to general funds.'
