STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of Certain County Officials of Kennebec County and Judges and Associate Judges of Municipal Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. The 7th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959, which relates to Kennebec County, is amended to read as follows:

'Kennebec County: County commissioners, $\$\pm,750$ \$1,850; chairman, \$2,000 \$2,100; clerk of courts, \$4,200 \$4,700; county attorney, \$3,000; assistant county attorney, \$2,000; treasurer, \$3,750; sheriff, $\$\pm,800$ \$5,300; register of deeds, \$5,000 \$5,500; judge of probate, \$6,000; register of probate, \$4,000; Augusta municipal court judge, \$3,300; recorder, \$1,900; Gardiner municipal court judge, \$2,100 \$2,400; recorder, \$1,200 \$1,500; Hallowell municipal court judge, \$500; Waterville municipal court judge, \$3,700 \$4,200; recorder, \$1,900; Winthrop municipal court judge, \$1,600 \$1,800.'
