STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Waldo County and Judge and Recorder of Waldo County Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. The 15th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959, which relates to Waldo County, is amended to read as follows:

'Waldo County: County commissioners, \$1,000; clerk of courts, \$3,000 \$3,800; county attorney, \$2,500 \$3,000; treasurer, \$1,000 \$1,200; sheriff, \$3,600 \$4,000; register of deeds, \$2,900 \$3,200; judge of probate, \$2,650 \$3,200; register of probate, \$2,900 \$3,200; Waldo County municipal court judge, \$2,800 \$3,700; recorder, \$1,500 \$1,802.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. The salary increases as set forth in section I shall be retroactive to January I, 1961.

Sec. 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Attorney General the sum of \$250 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1961; the sum of \$500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and the sum of \$500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 to provide for the increase in salary of the county attorney of Waldo County. The breakdown shall be as follows:
