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**AN ACT Permitting Counties to Reimburse Other Counties When Court Cases Transferred.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 28-A, additional. Chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new section 28-A, to read as follows:

‘Sec. 28-A. Change of venue in criminal cases. Whenever a criminal case has been transferred for trial from one county to another, the county commissioners of the county from which the case has been removed are authorized to pay to the other county all costs of court incurred by the trial.’
