STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Designation and Expenditures Under Town Road Improvement Fund Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 23, § 61, amended. The last sentence of section 61 of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Such designation and the expenditure of money under the provisions of sections for to 65 shall be under the supervision and approval of **municipal officers and** the commission.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 23, § 62, amended. The first sentence of section 62 of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 17 of the public laws of 1955, is further amended to read as follows:

'The expenditures of this fund shall not exceed the sum of \$6,000 \$12,000 in any one mile; except in unusual circumstances higher expenditures may be approved by the commission at its discretion.'
