STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Private Roads in Unorganized Territory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 174, § 14, amended. Section 14 of chapter 174 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, to read as follows:

'In roads privately owned in unorganized territory notwithstanding the other provisions of this chapter, no title or interest shall be aquired agianst the owners thereof by adverse possession, prescription or acquiesence, however exclusive or long continued.'
