AN ACT Relating to Open Season to Hunting with Bow and Arrow.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 109, amended. The first sentence of the first paragraph of section 109 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'An archery license shall be issued by the commissioner to take deer under sections 108 to 112, the fee for which shall be \$4.25 for hunting deer by residents of this State and \$10.25 for hunting deer by nonresidents; except that such archery licenses shall also permit the hunting of such wild birds and animals which can be legally hunted ~~during the month of October of each calendar year in Zone 1, from October 1st to October 26th in Zone 2 and from October 1st to October 14th in Zone 3.~~
