HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to S.P. 377, L.D. 1188, Bill, "An Act
Providing for Local Option to Transport School Children
to Other Than Public Schools Without State Subsidy."

Amend said Bill in paragraph E by striking out the first
sentence of subparagraph 3 and inserting in place thereof the
following underlined sentence:

'Expenditures or appropriations under paragraph E
shall not be valid in any municipality unless
authorized by a 2/3 vote of the legal voters, present
and voting, at any regular city election or at any
annual town meeting.'
