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**AN ACT Defining Mother, Father and Parent under Maine State Retirement Law.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1. R. S., c. 63-A, § 1, amended.** Section 1 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955 and as amended, is further amended by inserting after the 10th paragraph, a new paragraph, as follows:

‘ **“Father” shall mean natural father, or step father, or foster father.**’

**Sec. 2. R. S., c. 63-A, § 1, amended.** Section 1 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955 and as amended, is further amended by inserting after the 12th paragraph, a new paragraph, as follows:

‘ **“Mother” shall mean natural mother, or step mother, or foster mother.**’

**Sec. 3. R. S., c. 63-A, § 1, amended.** Section 1 of chapter 63-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 417 of the public laws of 1955 and as amended by section 1 of chapter 367 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended by inserting after the 13th paragraph, a new paragraph, as follows:

‘ **“Parent” shall mean natural mother or father, step mother, step father, foster mother, foster father.**’
