STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Director of Legislative Research.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 10, § 26, sub-§ VII, amended. The last sentence of subsection VII of section 26 of chapter 10 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 1 of chapter 361 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'He (Director of Legislative Research) shall receive a salary of \$10,000 \$11,500 per year and any necessary traveling expenses;'

There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$1,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and \$1,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 to carry out the purposes of this section.)

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall be retroactive to July 1, 1961.
