STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salary of Secretary of State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 21, § 1, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 1 of chapter 21 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 6 of chapter 361 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'The Secretary of State shall receive an annual salary of \$10,000 \$11,500. He and his deputy shall also receive such actual traveling expenses incident to the administration of his department as shall be necessary.'

(There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$1,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and \$1,500 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 to carry out the purposes of this section.)

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall be retroactive to July 1, 1961.
