AN ACT Relating to County Appropriations for Industrial Development.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 16-A, additional. Chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 16-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 16-A. Industrial development appropriation. Any county may expend not exceeding the sum of \$20,000 annually under the direction of the county commissioners, to be accounted for as other moneys of the county, for the employment of such personnel as it deems necessary for the industrial growth and development of the county.'
