**AN ACT Requiring Persons Seventy-Five Years of Age to Take Examination
for Motor Vehicle Driver's License.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 60, amended. Section 60 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding after the 6th sentence, a new sentence, as follows:

'Any person upon reaching his 75th birthday shall be required to take an examination to qualify him to operate a motor vehicle and shall be required to take such examination annually thereafter.
