STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Temporary Motor Vehicle Number Plates for Nonresident Members of Armed Services.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 31-A, amended. Section 31-A of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 8 of chapter 76 of the public laws of 1957 and amended by section 26 of chapter 429 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended by adding after the first sentence, a new sentence, as follows:

'If the purchaser of such motor vehicle or boat trailer is a nonresident member of the armed services, said purchaser may operate the same for a period not to exceed 20 consecutive days thereafter without payment of a regular fee.'
