STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Competitive Bids Under Maine Industrial
Building Authority Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38-B, § 6, sub-§ IX, additional. Section 6 of chapter 38-B of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 421 of the public laws of 1957, and as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection IX, to read as follows:

‘IX. Competitive bids. To award by a system of competitive bidding any contract or expenditure for any buildings or materials or work involving a total cost of more than \$100,000, except contracts for professional, architectural and engineering services, where the credit of the State of Maine is used in connection with mortgaged loans and in connection with this chapter, except that the Maine Industrial Authority shall have full right not to use competitive bidding whenever it seems that same is inadvisable to carry out the intent and purposes of this chapter.’
