IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Service of Process on Insurance Commissioner.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 60, § 62, amended. The last sentence of section 62 of chapter 60 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘When a legal process against an insurance company is served on the commissioner, he shall record the following information and keep it in his office for 2 years: Names of the parties; name and address of the attorney for the plaintiff; name of the person who served the process; and date and time of service. After recording this information, he shall mail the process to the secretary of the company.’

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 60, § 210, repealed and replaced. Section 210 of chapter 60 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Sec. 210. Copy of all processes forwarded. When a legal process against a company described in section 208 is served on the commissioner, he shall record the following information and keep it in his office for 2 years: Names of the parties; name and address of the attorney for the plaintiff; name of the person who served the process; and date and time of service. After recording this information, he shall mail the process to the secretary of the company.’
