# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Relating to Authority of Certain Railroad Police.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 46, § 10-A, additional. Chapter 46 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 10-A, to read as follows:

#### 'Railroad Police.

Sec. 10-A. Any deputy sheriff employed to exercise police supervision upon the property, and in connection with the property, of a railroad, while on duty shall have the same authority to pursue, arrest and prosecute as a regular member of the State police.'
