STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Fee for Entry of Civil Action in Superior Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. I. R. S., c. 89, § 98-A, additional. Chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 98-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 98-A. Fee for entry of action. Every attorney shall pay to the clerk of the Superior Court an entry fee of \$3 for each civil action entered. There shall be no charge to any attorney by said court for blank writs or summonses, for issuing any execution, any execution renewal, any writ of possession or for taxing cost.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 89, § 99, repealed. Section 99 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 190 of the public laws of 1959, is repealed.
