STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Experience Rating Record of Employers Under Employment Security Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 29, § 17, sub-§ III, ¶ C, amended. Paragraph C of subsection III of section 17 of chapter 29 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
 - 'C. For the purposes of paragraph A of this subsection, the experience rating record of the most recent subject employer shall not be charged with benefits paid to a claimant whose work record with such employer totaled 58 consecutive work weeks or less but in such case the most recent subject employer with whom claimant's work record exceeded 58 consecutive work weeks shall be charged if such employer would have otherwise been chargeable had not subsequent employment intervened.'
